

In accordance to CDC protocol, Kikuchi Oral Surgery & Dental Implant Center will implement the following precautionary measures for the safety of patients & staff as follows:

- If you have TRAVELED out of the state in the past (2) WEEKS, we will postpone treatment.
- We will obtain TEMPERATURES upon entering the treatment area. If your temperature is 99F or above, you will be asked to postpone treatment and reschedule for a later time.
- If you have a persistent COUGH, you will be asked to postpone treatment and reschedule for a later time.
- If patients have ANY symptoms such as: coughing, fever, sore throat, and shortness of breath, you will be asked to postpone treatment and reschedule for a later time.
- Only ONE FAMILY MEMBER will be allowed in the waiting room. All other family members are to stay in the car.
- All magazines, touch screen devices, charging ports and technology WILL NOT BE available for communal use.
- All outside food and drinks, including our own coffee and snack bar WILL NOT BE PERMITTED until further notice.

We are taking EVERY PRECAUTION recommended by the ADA (American Dental Association) and NDA (Nevada Dental Association) to keep our patients, and staff safe, including:

- Following proper infection control, including: wiping down all surfaces between patient use, including chairs, cabinets, counter tops, door handles and monitors both in the clinic and in the waiting room.
- Using single use disposable drapes, headrest covers, light handle covers.
- Thoroughly sterilizing any instrument or item that comes in contact with a patient. Wearing full protective equipment, including sterile gowns, masks, protective eyewear, and single use gloves.
- Staggering patient visits to limit the number of people in the waiting rooms.
